WEBSITE PRIVACY STATEMENT**

**1. ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS**

Gideon Technologies, Inc. ("Gideon") is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Statement sets forth our current privacy practices with regard to the information we collect when you or your computer interact with our website located at <http://www.gideontechnologies.com> and related web pages ("Site"). By accessing the Site, you accept and agree to Gideon's Site Privacy Statement and freely consent to the information collection, use and dissemination practices described in this Site Privacy Statement.

**2. INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND HOW WE USE IT**

Gideon collects certain information from and about its users three ways: directly from our Web Server logs, information submitted by the user, and with Cookies.

**a. WEB SERVER LOGS.**

When you visit our Site, we may track information to administer the site and analyze its usage. Examples of information we may track include:

- Your Internet protocol address.
- Number of links you click within our Site.
- State or country from which you accessed our Site.
- Date and time of your visit.
- The length of time you were connected to our Site and specific pages within our Site.
- Name of your Internet service provider.
- Pages you viewed on the site.

**b. USE OF COOKIES**

Gideon uses cookies to control access to restricted areas of our Site and personalize or enhance your user experience. A cookie is a small text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web Page Server. We do not use cookies to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a Web Server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies. If you reject cookies by changing your browser settings then be aware that this may disable some of the functionality on our Site and prevent your ability to access certain restricted areas of our Site.

**c. PERSONAL INFORMATION USERS**

When you register for certain services on our Site, we may request some personal information such as name, address, email, telephone number, and other relevant information. For other types of registrations, we may ask for other relevant information so that we can provide assistance and information to you. For example, such data may be warranted in order to provide online technical support and troubleshooting. We may share certain aggregated demographic information that we collect with our business partners regarding the users of the Site. The aggregated information that we provide is not directly linked to any personally identifiable information. We will share your personally identifiable information within our business for the purposes of furthering our business, including analyzing your information and other uses.

We will use your personally identifiable information to provide information or perform services that you request we, or a third party, provide or perform. We may also use such information to welcome you to the Site, thank you, communicate with you and explain new offerings and features. If the applicable information is to be provided or service is to be performed by a third party, then we will disclose the applicable information to the third party providing the information or performing the applicable service.

- **THIRD PARTY MARKETING:** We may share your personally identifiable information with our affiliates and other business partners who work on behalf of or with the Company under confidentiality obligations. These companies may use your personal information to assist the Company in communicating with you about the Site, the Company



or other offerings of the Company or our business partners. Such third parties do not have any independent right to disclose your personally identifiable information.

- **EXCEPTIONS:**

- We may use and disclose your personally identifiable information to the extent reasonably necessary to:
  - correct technical problems and malfunctions in how we provide our products and services to you and to technically process your information;
  - protect the security and integrity of the Site and our Internet service, including without limitation to enforce our Terms of Use with you;
  - protect our rights and property and the rights and property of others;
  - take precautions against liability;
  - respond to claims that your information violates the rights and interests of third parties;
  - the extent required by law or to respond to judicial process;
  - the extent permitted under other provisions of law, to provide personal information to law enforcement agencies or for an investigation on a matter related to public safety;
  - the extent required in connection with a merger, acquisition, or liquidation of the company; and
  - third-party service providers and contractors (such as the Site webmaster) that are contractually obligated to protect your information as disclosed in this Web Privacy Policy.
- You understand and agree that technical processing of your information is and may be required to:
  - send and receive messages regarding your use of the Site;
  - conform to the technical requirements of connecting networks;
  - conform to the limitations of our service; or
  - conform to other, similar technical requirements.

- **LINKS TO OTHER SITES:** This Site may contain links to other Sites. We are not responsible for and shall not have any liability arising from the privacy practices or the content of other Sites.
- **STORAGE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION:** We store information collected via the Site, including without limitation your personally identifiable information, indefinitely.
- **USER FORUMS:** You should always consider that information (personal or otherwise) provided in the context of user forums such as chat rooms, bulletin boards, etc. will be available for viewing and use by other forum participants.

Gideon is committed to protecting your personal information provided via our Site just like we are committed to helping our customers protect their privacy and the privacy of their customers.

### **3. THIRD PARTY LINKS**

Gideon uses third party business solutions such as Google™ Analytics on our Site to enhance your overall experience. Such third party links from this Site have their own privacy statements that can be viewed by clicking on the corresponding links within each respective Site. Since we do not have direct control over the policies or practices of such third parties, we are not responsible for the privacy practices or contents of those sites. We recommend and encourage that you always review the privacy policies of such third parties before you provide any personal information or complete any transaction with such parties.

### **4. ACCESSING WEB ACCOUNT INFORMATION**

We will provide you with the means to ensure that personally identifiable information in your web account file is correct and current. You may review this information by contacting us by sending an email to our support attendant info "at" gideontechnologies.com.

### **5. CHANGES TO THIS STATEMENT**

We reserve the right to change or modify our information collection, use and disclosure practices set forth in this Web Privacy Policy. If we decide to change our Web Privacy Policy, we will post those changes on the Site so our users and customers are always aware of what information we collect, use and disclose. If at any point we decide to use or disclose your personally identifiable information in a manner different from that stated at the time it was collected, we will notify you in writing, which may or may not be by e-mail. If you object to the change to our Web Privacy Policy, then you must contact us using the information provided in the notice. We will otherwise use and disclose a user's or a customer's personally identifiable information in accordance with the Web Privacy Policy that was in effect when such information was collected.



## 6. CHANGE IN CONTROL.

If the Company experiences a “change in control” (defined below), then we may amend our information practices as described in this Web Privacy Policy. We will disclose your personally identifiable information to the company or other legal entity that succeeds our operation of the Site. The privacy policy of the succeeding legal entity will then govern the personally identifiable information that we have collected from you under this Web Privacy Policy. However, if applicable law prohibits the succeeding legal entity’s privacy policy from governing your personally identifiable information, then this Web Privacy Policy shall continue to govern.

“Change in control” means any of the following events:

- we undergo a reorganization, merger, consolidation, acquisition or other restructuring involving all or substantially all of our voting securities and/or assets, by operation of law or otherwise;
- we become insolvent;
- we make a general assignment for the benefit of creditors;
- we suffer or permit an appointment of a receiver for our business or assets;
- we become subject to any proceedings under any bankruptcy or insolvency law, whether domestic or foreign; or
- we are liquidated, voluntarily or otherwise.
